Tracey Lee Cassin is an award-winning published International artist and photographer. Home is Lake Rotoma, a beautiful lakeside community in the Bay Of Plenty of New Zealand.

Her creative practice is multifaceted as a painter, mixed media artist, writer, and photographer, with works in private collections in New Zealand, Australia, the USA, United Kingdom, Scotland and Italy.

Her practice explores many artistic aspects, particularly the fundamentals of space, shape, and colour using various mediums, including oils, watercolour, ink, printmaking, collage, and acrylics.

The sculptural use of paint with a palette knife and spatula is a personal passion.

Contemporary seascapes feature prominently in her body of work. As an artistic photographer, she has a special interest in macro, digital manipulation, and the creation of inspirational quotation photography.

The inspiration for her art and photography are the patterns and colours found in nature and the human face, music, lyrics and poetry. Tracey Lee is the founder and creative director of 'Mia Bella Passions - Art, Home and Garden Website', which she began in 2012 to share her love of creativity, DIY, design and decor.

I've had the fortune of engaging with, and enjoying Tracey Lee's' painted works for a number of years now, and I'm pleased to offer the following reflections:


Tracey Lee possesses incredibly intuitive talent and technical proficiency within several creative realms, though it is her contemporary seascapes alone which compel me to testimony.





IVAN KANCHEV

Ivan Kanchev was born on September 17, 1973 in Ruse. In 2000 he has graduated in Ceramics at the National Academy of Arts in Sofia, and in 2006 in Psychology at the University of Ruse "Angel Kanchev". He defended his doctoral dissertation in art history and fine arts at the Department of Sculpture, and in 2010-11 he was a part-time lecturer in sculpture at the Department of Ceramics at the National Academy of Arts. Ivan has had dozens of solo exhibitions of his work, and participated in many group exhibitions in Bulgaria, and in prestigious ceramics forums in Italy, Spain, Japan, Poland, Denmark, France, Belgium, Switzerland, China, Austria, Germany, Portugal, Croatia, USA, and others. He has won national and international awards (Second prize in the international competition for the Art of Unity Creative Award, New York (2021); "GOLD LIST Special Edition - The best contemporary artists of today" in Art Magazine. Global Media Company (2021); Market Recognition Award, Light Space & Time Art Gallery, Palm Springs, CA, USA (2021). His works are in prestigious galleries and museums around the world. He is the author of curatorial projects and several books in the field of sculpture and ceramics.

Project "Man, where are you? ("Night Visions"), 2012-2022

The project "Man, where are you?" concerns current problems of the present existence. Everything is fragmented in ecological, social and political terms. The earth is "notched". The man is small and naked, confused and defenseless, represented with outstretched arms and legs apart - in poetic and artistic crucifix. It is an object-subject, center and periphery, meaning and time.

The man runs, looking to find his foundations. His human nature is shaken. Embroiled in the mosaic of continuing problems, frantically seeks happiness in the maze of life. But is he able to come to his senses and find himself? Will he find happiness in this direction of search?


The depicted scenes with clay and fire in "Man, where are you?" are nocturnal, as in a dream, as picture visions. Thematically they are derived from the heritage of universal history and culture. The monumental vessel shape is symbolic. The circle is like an echo of the ideal, like an image of Mother Earth, like the Sun. The rectangle is reminiscent of the human existence, the boundaries of time, space and corporeality".

ALINE POUGET

Aline Pouget is a French artist whose favorite technique is oil on canvas or wood. Aline Pouget has exhibited around the world, New York, Vienna, Paris, Deauville. She has been invited to the Florence Biennales in 2019 and 2021, Barcelona 2019, Mantua 2019, Milan 2021, the Vatican Chancellery in 2022, the Rome Triennial in 2021 as well as the Venice Pro-Biennale 2021. She also participated in the UNESCO-sponsored Woman's Essence Show in 2020 in Rome.

Aline Pouget has received many international awards, the most prestigious of which are the Artist of the Year 2020 for the Best in Art & Creativity, the Golden Lion of Venice in 2021 and the Oscar for Artistic Creativity in 2021 as well as the Grand Prix de Rome 2021, she is due to receive in June the Top 60 Masters Award in New York.

Aline Pouget's works have been published, among others, in "TOP 10 CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS", "MoMA - World of Art Contemporary ArtMagazine", "Guggenheim Museum issue", "50 Artists to INVEST IN" and "ARTISTIC GENIUSES OF TODAY".

Aline Pouget, signs of eternity

"My work stems from the observation of nature, life, reactions and human feelings. It's a mixture of observations, emotions, my feelings. »

From the earth to heaven, according to the observations that the reality of the world offers her, Aline Pouget restores a universe where nature, the city and the cosmos meet each other. The painter balances the lived and the imaginary. On the edge of the figurative and the abstract, his works confuse the viewer to take him to escape and dream. From the obvious to the mirage, his gesture frees, dissolves the composition. The degree of abstraction stays on course towards lines of leaks that structure the gaze to the margins of the surface of the canvas. In this diffuse where the loss of landmarks dominates, the painter always seeks to bring out something recognizable. A tree, a setting sun, a sailboat, a suspension bridge, buildings...

His preferred technique is oil on canvas or wood. She works a radiant palette. The density of pigments induces depths that testify to the emotional charge of its creation.

"The attraction to the color and light around us gives me such a sense of happiness that I want to share it with everyone."

Aline paints as she feels. It summons this omnipotence of perception to exalt the senses in search of harmony and a certain pictorial enchantment.

Even in the city, his vision remains naturalistic and lyrical. The decor preserves something wild and lush. The energy staged cosmic breath. A sensation of floating movement emerges and tends towards a joyful apocalypse, especially for its Space series.

This aesthetic chaos represents the sublime of a paradise rediscovered as a twilight vision. The contemplative and atmospheric value of his painting invites us to construct our own representation, towards a destiny that everyone can compose between consciousness and unconsciousness, truth and illusion, light, and shadow.

This real dazzling journey of landscapes jostled by the hand of the artist contributes to a feeling of serenity sometimes slightly disturbed by the tumult of the waves, or a stormy sky.

"Through my works, I want to share my emotions and feelings by revealing the intimate meaning of my thoughts, my experiences of life and my moods. »

Aline Pouget takes us on a journey of her own where the stories dedicated to the sensitive unfold under the changes of heaven, where the atmosphere depicted reveals signs of eternity.






Inspired by the great masters of the 20th century, and especially by the artistic movements of impressionism, post-impressionism and expressionism, Irena Procházková prefers oil painting, using a wide array of colours that transmit the positive view of the world that the artist has. It's a painting of great introspective tension, fed by sentiments and pathos, that shows the pictorial culture of an artist that's able to reach an extremely personal and exclusive style.

Each subject shows an innate personality and is enveloped by a vivid atmosphere of poetical traits, where the colourful dimension obtains a relevant role, contributing to conveying introspective depth to the whole. The lines, decisive and impactful, assume an interpretative role, and combined with the communicative potentiality of the colour allow the real to transform into imaginary.

The explosive strength of the chromatic expressivity shows intense narrations where man and nature become the preferred subject and field of investigation. Daily scenes, moments of life, emotions and states of mind are translated into scenes never fully defined, rendered alive through the use of allusive and fascinating colours.

This rich pictorial synthaxis is based on a vibrant polyphony of colours and on a figuration that, in the perceptive vividness and the imaginary re-elaboration, determines the preciousness of the narrative plot.







LA POETICA DELL'IMMAGINARIO

Una narrazione sospesa nel tempo, nell'apparizione magica ed inconsueta di figure e cose, poste tra la visione ed il ricordo, distingue la narrazione figurativa del maestro Franco Tagliati, mentre i dati espressivi coniugano armoniosamente il senso con la ragione, l'analisi concettuale con la lirica trasfigurazione del reale, tra atmosfere surreali nei trapassi di una calda luminosità che si irradia nelle scenografie trasognate. È un mondo evocativo e poetico, in cui la realtà visionaria appare in un'ambientazione fantasiosa che approda a spazi surreali nel vigore espressivo. Ecco che allora, le visioni oniriche nell'immediata gestualità pittorica e nella brillantezza delle tonalità, tra i rossi fiammeggianti, i gialli solari, i verdi variegati della natura e gli azzurri intensi, rimandano ad una lettura simbolica, dove l'arcano disvela i suoi segreti, tra sogni archetipi ed aspettative, in cui primeggia la magia dell'inconfondibile sorpresa di una quotidiana teatralità, suscitando il fascino e mistero dell'esistenza. In ogni dipinto di Franco Tagliati risalta il senso assoluto del colore nel raffinato e caldo cromatismo che traduce nelle immagini sognanti il genio nella creatività, l'estro e la poesia, in cui si svela l'alchimia coloristica nella fervida fantasia. Nascono, così, splendidi dipinti che interpretano gli aspetti psicologici e formalistici dell'uomo, tra contraddizioni ed ambiguità dove la realtà e fantasia del reale si integrano in una surrealtà che s'inoltra nella ricerca dell'impossibile, da Magritte a Picasso, seguendo l'ideale surrealista, in cui le immagini si abbandonano alle forze del meraviglioso e dell'inconscio. Stupisce, quindi, la narrazione fantomatica che determina spazi sognanti, mentre percorrono un utopico viaggio del pensiero nella poetica dell'immaginario. Oltre la stessa concettualizzazione dell'immagine, traspare nel percorso figurativo del maestro Franco Tagliati, in un racconto allusivo, quanto, fantastico che si snoda nei significati simbolici della vita. In tal modo, la narrazione simbolico-espressionista fonde l'analisi concettuale con la fantasia, cioè la tangibilità realistica dei dati figurali che sono pervasi da una luce soffusa, mentre i personaggi della memoria popolano il mondo evocativo dell'autore. Ecco perché, c'è qualcosa di magico che aleggia nei dipinti del maestro Franco Tagliati: un teatro di luci si armonizza nel colore, mentre i dati figurali vivono di una loro segreta realtà. E' il fascino di una pittura che si fa poesia, nell'emozionalità del colore carico di simbologie che interpretano un logos ideale di sensazioni in un clima silente che diviene rivelazione e visione fantastica tra metafore, apologhi morali, pulsioni e sentimento, dove la meravigliosa scenografia sublima l'arte nell'incanto di un sogno.










